Updated Notice on Requirements for Travelling to Nepal

Following the latest decision of the government of Nepal, all passengers travelling to Nepal are required to follow the guidelines as below:

- 1. The applicants from the countries which are authorized to get visa-on-arrival as per the existing law and have been fully vaccinated are authorized to get Visa-on-arrival. Such foreign nationals who apply visa at Immigration entry points of Nepal should submit the following documents in addition to the visa related documents for visa on arrival:
 - a) Evidence of the completion of 14 days of full vaccination against COVID-19,
 - b) A COVID-19 negative report (RT-PCR, Gene Expert, True NAAT or WHO accredited test) obtained within 72 hours of the departure from first port of embarkment or within 72 hours, if entering Nepal by land.
 - c) A copy of mountaineering or trekking permit or other related permits if any,
 - d) A proof of hotel reservation in Nepal,
 - e) A print of the International Traveller Online Arrival Form obtained after filling up the form at www.ccmc.gov.np.
- 2. Foreigners without complete vaccinations against COVID-19, must obtain the visa from the Nepali diplomatic missions abroad and are allowed to enter Nepal only through agencies. Such foreigners should submit the documents as aforementioned in 1 (b), (c), (d) and (e) and are subject to 10 days hotel quarantine at their own cost and are permitted to work as per the purpose of their visit only if they tested negative on the 11th day.
- 3. Non-resident Nepali or their family members or foreigners married to Nepali national should submit the documents as aforementioned in 1(a), (b) and (e) in addition to the visa related documents for on arrival visa.
 - However, those departing Nepal in the case of emergency enlisted below are permitted to move towards the destination only if tested antigen negative, else are subject to isolation following the health protocols.
 - a) Those travelling Nepal with the recommendation letter of the local level to attend the funeral of their relative according to the religion, custom and tradition.
 - b) Chronic patients, disabled and the persons accompanying them with the medical documents and recommendation letter of local level.
 - c) Senior citizens above 75 years and their caregivers, minors below 5 years and their parents with the recommendation of the local level.

- d) Those travelling Nepal with medical documents and recommendation of the local level to look after their relative admitted in ICU or ventilator.
- 4. Officials, employees, and their family members working in the diplomatic missions and international organizations in Nepal should submit the documents as aforementioned in 1 (a), (b) and (e) in addition to the visa related documents to obtain visa on arrival at the entry/exit points.
 - However, those without complete vaccinations against COVID-19, must obtain a visa from the Nepalese Diplomatic Missions abroad and are subject to 10 days mandatory quarantine at the specified residence recommended by their respective mission.
- 5. No vaccination or testing is required for the minors below 5 years. Vaccinations are not mandatory for the children between 8 to 19 years but are subject to follow other procedures as adults.
